

ROADWATER VILLAGE FETE AND PRODUCE SHOW - SATURDAY JULY 28th 2018

- A supply of 'orange entry slips' will be available at Roadwater Shop prior to Fete Day
- Entries should be received at the Marquee between 10am & 12noon on Fete Day
- The entrance fee is 30p per entry - £3.00 for 10 entries or more. A competitor may not enter more than one item in any class and may not enter items previously exhibited at Roadwater Fete.
- Please cover baked items with clingfilm and present on disposable plates or boards.
- The Silver Challenge Cup will be presented to the competitor with the highest number of points gained in sections 1 & 2.
- The Ladies Trophy will cover all sections.
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point
- If, in Section 1, there is only 1 entry in any class, this will be judged in Class 4 or 18. In other sections, adult classes may be amalgamated at the judges discretion. Children may enter any adult class.
- GENERAL NOTE: Exhibits in sections 1, 2 & 3 will be sold in aid of Roadwater Village Trust.
